ScholarTrack is your one-stop shop for all state financial aid information!

With your ScholarTrack account, you can*:

- Apply for state financial aid, such as the 21st Century Scholarship and Next Generation Hoosier Educators Scholarship
- Complete your Scholar Success Program activities (both high school and college)
- Check the status of your FAFSA, college credit completion, and more
- See what financial aid you are being offered from the state
- Submit and view appeals
- Access additional college and career success resources

*Some of these elements require a full account (created with your Social Security Number).

Setting up Your ScholarTrack account:

1. Go to **www.scholartrack.che.in.gov** (or Google ScholarTrack)
2. Click on **Register** for an account at the bottom of the page. If you already have an account, enter your **Email** and **Password** below.




